### Rent-Geared-to-Income Subsidy

The City has launched MyAccesstoHousingTO, a new online application portal for households applying for or managing their existing application for Rent-Geared-to-Income housing. Applicants who are already on the Centralized Waiting List will need a unique code to log in, which is being sent in the mail between July and November. If you have an existing application, please watch the registration video ...

Rent-Geared-to-Income (RGI), or subsidized housing, is made available by the City of Toronto to make rent affordable for households. In most cases, the rent at a subsidized unit is 30 per cent of a household's total monthly income before taxes and adjustments. If you receive social assistance the rent is based on the rent benefit set by the Ontario government.



## **Applicant Registration Rates**



- Target: 50% adoption by June 30th
- 53k applicants in portal (former and net new)



## **Applicant Engagement Strategies**

### DA / Applicants in Shelter

- Cross reference CWL with BNL/SMIS
- Update DA codes
- Communication with Shelters re: current clients and action required for Access to Housing
- Virtual Meetings / On-site registration meetings
- Expanded invitations to CB for DA applicants with 2020 application year or older.

### **Seniors**

- Mail campaign
- Call-out campaign
  - A2H staff called 1200 seniors providing information and updating contact information in files

#### **Choice-Based Housing Offer Process**


The City has implemented a new way to access Rent-Geared-to-Income (RGI) housing in Toronto called the choice-based housing offer process. You will receive an invite if you have a priority status or an application date of December 31, 2012 and earlier.

### **Choice Base Cycles**

- Choice Based Module Implemented
  - Pilot in November/December 2021
  - Full implementation January 2022

- Cohort of applicants invited to CB Cycles
  - Priority Applicants; Chronological 2013 or older; DA 2020 or older
  - View current RGI units: photos, amenities, maps, floorplans
  - Express interest



## Single Offer Rule

- Implemented as of January 1, 2022
- Taking educational approach with applicants
- Information/Reminders included:
  - communications
  - website
  - within MyAccesstoHousingTO
  - reminder at time of Expression of Interest



### 176 Elm: Front Counter Service

- Soft Launch April 19<sup>th</sup> and formal opening April 25, 2022
- Soon: Online Booking System
  - Applicants can book appointments for wicket and computers
  - Support agencies, Phone channel can book appointments for Applicants
  - Walk-in appointments also accepted
