

## Ontario Consolidated Homelessness Prevention Program

Consolidates three programs as of April 1 2022:

- Community Homelessness Prevention Initiative
- Home for Good
- Strong Communities Rent Supplement Program

Meant to provide more flexibility for municipal service managers to prevent homelessness


Access to this funding requires having a **By-name List** in place that meets provincial requirements

Annual funding increase of \$25 million overall

Additional \$6.7 million in the Indigenous Supportive Housing Program

New investments can be used to fund the operation of supportive housing units created through the province's Social Services Relief Fund (SSRF)
