PARTY	TOTAL	SHARE
Progressive Conservative	83	40.8%
New Democrat	31	23.7%
Liberal	8	23.8%
Green	1	6.0%
Independent	1	0.5%

Voter turnout - approximately 43.5%

3 City Councillors won seats:

- Kristyn Wong-Tam - NDP in Toronto Centre
- Mary-Margaret McMahon - Liberals in Beaches-East York
- Michael Ford - for the Progressive Conservatives in York South-Weston
