#### Ontario Election - June 2

#### Vote 4 Housing Ontario

- 1. Build and acquire 99,000 deeply affordable non-profit, co-op, and supportive homes in the next 10 years.
- 2. Reinvest in existing community housing by supporting needed repairs and renewal, and ongoing funding for rental assistance.
- 3. Implement an urban, rural, and northern Indigenous housing strategy for Ontario with dedicated investments through an Indigenous-led approach.
- 4. Commit to creating a strategy to end chronic homelessness, with clear and measurable targets and timelines, and matching investments.
- 5. Pledge to make renting a secure and viable option for Ontarians




